

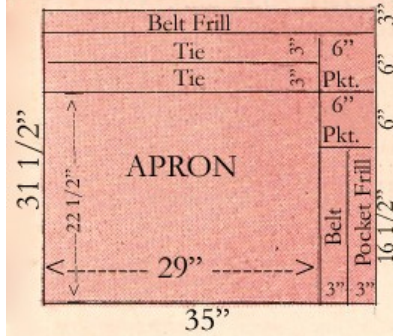
MAKE THIS JAUNTY APRON WITH BIAS TRIM BANDS



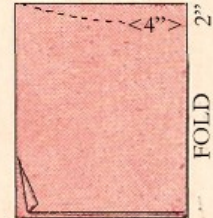
The apron requires $\frac{7}{8}$ yard of medium weight plain cotton material, 1 card of J. & P. Coats Fine Nainsook or Fine Percalé Bias Trim in a gay color and 2 cards in a contrasting darker color. Note the color number of the Bias Trim and select J. & P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Mercerized Sewing thread by number to exactly match. Peasant color combinations—Orange and Emerald Bias Trim on white cotton. Blue and Autumn Red Bias Trim on pink. Red and Navy Bias Trim on light blue.

TO MAKE THE APRON—Sketch 1 gives the dimensions for cutting. Sketch 2 shows how to shape the waistline. Fold fabric the short way through the center as shown. Measure down 2 inches from the top of the fold, and cut straight in from this point 4 inches and gradually up to the left corner of the folded material as shown by the dotted lines.

- 1 Baste and stitch band of the brighter Bias Trim across apron, 6 inches from bottom.
- 2 Bind sides and bottom of apron with darker Bias Trim.
- 3 Gather top.
- 4 Bind ties with darker Bias Trim.
- 5 Bind frill with darker Bias Trim and gather it.
- 6 Turn edges of belt to inside; baste over gathered edges of apron, frill and gathered ends of ties before sewing on waist band.
- 7 Turn edges of belt facing, baste, and stitch it in place to cover all raw edges, then stitch trimming bands to right side of waist band.
- 8 Turn and press raw edge at top of each pocket to right side, and press sides and bottom edges to the inside.
- 9 Bind and gather frill for pockets same as in step 5.
- 10 Baste frill to right side of pocket along top, baste and stitch a band of bright Bias Trim over raw edges.
- 11 Stitch a band of darker Bias Trim $\frac{1}{2}$ inch below top band.
- 12 Try apron on, pin pockets in place, baste and stitch them to apron.
